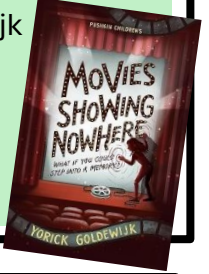


Homework Grid Summer 2

Read...

Movies Showing Nowhere

Write...

a play script, using a school as the main setting. This could include existing characters or new ones that you have created. Write your script so that it would be suitable for children aged 7 – 11.

Create...

a poster and ticket stub for our end of year play '*The Wrong Way Round*'.

Thursday 9th July at 6pm

Spend some time...

listening to an audiobook. This might be a book that you've already read or a completely new one. Try to shut off all other external noise and really immerse yourself in the story.

Calculate...

the total run time for a London play or musical. Calculate this for daily, weekly, monthly and annually. Don't forget different shows have different running times so you will need to do some research.

Research...

the history of The West End, London's famous theatre district.

Create a fact file to present your findings. Don't forget to include pictures and diagrams to support your research.

Investigate...

the different behind the scenes job roles in theatres. This could be any jobs from the costume designers to the people who check your tickets. Create a fact file aimed at people interested in getting a job in the theatre.

Visit...

London's West End. Wander around the bustling streets and find as many of the wonderful historical theatres as you can.

A local theatre. Collect some flyers for up-coming shows that you might be interested in watching.
