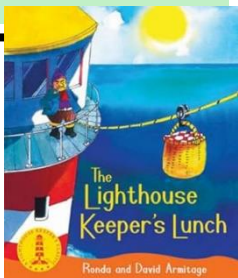

Homework Grid Summer Term 2

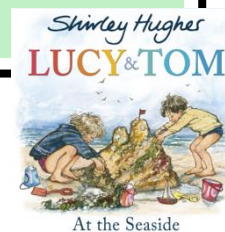


Welcome back for another exciting half term!

Pretend you have £10 to spend at the seaside. What would you buy? Can you add up the total cost?

Create...

a model sandcastle, boat or lighthouse using junk modelling or craft materials or you could draw or paint a seaside scene. You could include donkeys, deckchairs, ice cream, boats or a pier.
