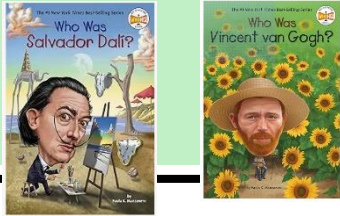


Read...

Any books from the Who was...? Series. They have many artists to choose from!

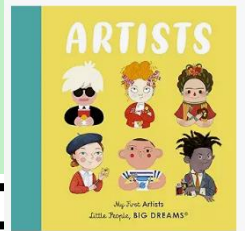


Homework Grid Summer Term 2

This term, Blackbird Class will have their homework tasks based on our exciting **Art Unit: Creative Responses inspired by Significant Artists**. Over the next term, it is expected that children will complete a minimum of four tasks from those suggested below. Children are invited to show/talk to the class about these tasks throughout the week when there is time.

Read...

Little People Big Dreams Artists or the Artists and Writers box set!



Write... a short biography about a significant artist you like the style of- from in class or your own interests. Include: When they lived, where they were from and what made their art special.

Create... your own art piece inspired by Andy Warhol.



Spend some time... painting or sketching what you see from your window or from a chair in your garden or a park.



Calculate...by looking at a painting Castle and Sun by Paul Klee, how many different colours have been used and the number of shapes or repeated patterns you can see. Could you then recreate the piece using a grid, trying to keep the scale of each section in proportion?



Research...the work of Lesley Richmond and create your own piece inspired by her use of textiles and trees. Use any extra mediums or tools that you like to complete your piece.



Investigate...the work of Barbara Hepworth and Jim Dine. Compare the similarities and differences between them. Present this as a poster, Venn diagram or labelled diagrams using their work or your own pieces created in their style.
