The daily acts of Collective Worship are planned to give everyone a variety of experiences to develop spirituality through reflection as well an understanding of Christianity and aspects of other faiths and cultures. They enable us to reflect on and respond to things which we as a school community believe are important in preparing children to be responsible citizens now and in the future. The experiences include involving children in sharing relevant stories and current events.

The Lord's Prayer is displayed on the 'Reflection Board', along with our own school prayer which was written by the pupils. Members of staff take it in turns to lead Collective Worship and every Thursday a member of our Ministry Team leads Collective Worship. At important times in the church calendar parents, governors and friends are invited to join us for services in the church or in school. Friday's Collective Worship is about celebration of happenings of the week, centred on our How to Bee ethos, culminating in one of the pupils leading prayer.
